Theme: Command To Construct The Ark

Memory Verse: Hebrews chapter eleven verse seven: "By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith"

Texts: Genesis 6: 14-16

Noah was instructed by God to build the ark for the salvation of his family. God gave specific instructions as to the materials for construction, the measurement and design of the ark. Noah continued the building by faith to the ridicule of the worldly men of that generation. No wonder the Bible says " By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.
