Theme: AUTHORITY OF MAN OVER GOD'S CREATION

Memory verse: *Genesis chapter one verse twenty-seven: So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created He him: male and female created He them.*

Texts: Genesis 1: 26-28, Psalm 8: 3-8

At the highest point of God's creative acts, a Divine counsel was summoned or called upon. Why was this necessary? This was necessary because God was about to create a special being, a master-piece, an original model Of Himself, superior creature, that would share in the life of God and rule over His works.
