Theme: Judgment Of The World Determined

Memory Verse: Genesis chapter six verse thirteen: "And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth"

Texts: Genesis 18:23-33, Acts 17:30,31

God noticed that the cup of their evil was full and He decided to destroy them. The judgment of God is also determined on the present world because of the evil and wickedness prevalent in it. It is no longer going to be by flood but by fire. The only means of escape then was repentance and obedience, which the people in the time of Noah despised. The only means of escape from the imminent final judgment is repentance and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

The account in the thirteenth verse of Genesis chapter six is further proof that Noah indeed found grace in the sight of God, as He disclosed His plan unto him. His determination to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah was not also kept secret from Abraham, the friend of God (Genesis 18:17). "Surely the Lord God will do nothing, but he revealed his secret unto his servant the prophets"(Amos 3:17).

This revelation turned Noah into a preacher of righteousness (2 Peter 2:5), while the news of God intent to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah moved Abraham to intercede for the cities. The information we have on this end-time should motivate us to talk to God on man's behalf and talk to man on God's behalf. We are God's ambassador's charge with this ministry of reconciliation (2 Corinthians 5:18-20). The question is what are you doing about this determine judgment of God? This is not time to keep quiet.
