Theme: PARDON FOR REPENTANT SINNER

Memory Verse: 1 John 1:9-10 "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. [10] If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us."

Texts: Isaiah 6:5-13

This drives the urgency of voluntary repentance home. The sinner or backslider must today turn to the Lord, "fall on this stone" and be broken for a broken and contrite heart God will not despise. But those who hold on to their sin till judgment day, then, the stone shall fall on them and grind them to powder (eternal doom in hell fire). Since the scripture cannot be broken, it will come to pass if the sinner remain hard hearted and refuse to repent.

This was a warning to the Jews at that time. He wanted them to repent and accept the Lord as the Saviour and the Son of God. But they rejected the Lord as the Saviour and the Son of God. God is bringing this same warning to us today. The sinner must turn from sin, and accept the Lord, fall on the stone out of personal volition and receive a change of heart. There cannot be any delay.

The Lord in His infinite mercy and faithful has given the sinner and the backslider an offer that money cannot by saying "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us" By abusing such an offer invite the anger of God, followed with His judgment. What is your decision today? Repentance for life or holding on to sin for judgment, death and damnation?
