

Theme: QUALIFICATION FOR SERVICE

Memory Verse: *Isaiah 52:11* “Depart ye, depart ye, go ye out from thence, touch no unclean thing; go ye out of the midst of her; be ye clean, that bear the vessels of the Lord”.

Texts: Song of Solomon 1:6; Hosea 10:12; 2 Timothy 2.15

The Master has the prerogative to decide who to hire and how to reward. Only those who meet the Master’s standard are the one is that He will hire. The labourers were qualified to do farm work; if not, the husbandman would not have hired them. In the Kingdom work, all our efforts to mould others will be fruitless except we are born again.

Labourers in the vineyard are to labour, one, to bring sinners to Christ “Why doth this man thus speak blasphemies? Who can forgive sins but God only? In addition, immediately when Jesus perceived in his spirit that they so reasoned within themselves, he said unto them, why reason you these things in your hearts? [9] Whether is it easier to say to the sick of the palsy, Thy sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and take up thy bed, and walk? (Mark 2:7-9).

Two, labourers are to win members of their own household (John 1:41,42); three, inspire other workers (Acts 1:25,26); four, save souls from death (John 5:20,21); five, publish glad tidings (Psalm 68:11) “The Lord gave the word: great was the company of those that published it” six, pray for souls into the Kingdom and establish converts; seven, serve and pray for the increase of labourers (Matthew 9:37-38) “ Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.
