Theme: PARABLES OF THE LABOURERS

Memory Verse: 1 Corinthians 15:58 "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord".

Texts: Mathew 20:1-16

The parable of the labourers in the vineyard is one of the parables the Lord Jesus told about the kingdom lifestyle. In the last verses of the previous chapter was a statement, which may astonish the ordinary mind about issues relating to God's kingdom. He said: "But many that are first shall be last; and the last shall be first" In order to drive the point home, Jesus gave this parable, which is the focus of our study these weeks.
