

Theme: JUDGMENT ON FRUITLESSNESS

Memory Verse: *John 15:2 “Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.”*

Texts: Mathew 21:19; 3:10; 7:19; Luke 13:6-9

There is no place for fruitlessness in the kingdom of God. In the natural, after creation, God pronounced the blessing of fruitfulness on mankind and beasts and indeed on all living creatures. “And God blessed them and God said unto them be fruitful and multiply...” (Genesis 1:28). “There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren in thy land...” (Exodus 23:26). Being born again therefore we are to “bring forth fruit unto God” (Roman 7:4). If, however, a believer shows all appearance of righteousness but lacks the fruit, where is therefore the blessedness being spoken of? (Galatians 4:15). The land that drinks the rain and refuses to yield its fruit is nigh unto cursing (Hebrews 6:7-8).

The fruitless believer is like the fig tree in Luke 13:6-9. Many have been in the church for many years but are not born again. They are not growing in grace. They have not fruits of repentance. There are others who have not won a soul for Christ. Many look very religious, dress like Christians, go out and come in with believers but bear no fruits. Many profess to be born again, sanctified and baptized in the Holy Ghost but their lifestyle drive people away from Christ and the Church.

Many carrying big Bibles make long prayers but they are totally barren. They cheat, defraud, fight, quarrel, abuse curse and do all manner of evil things. Such people are only cumbering the ground. All sinners in the church cannot expect that the hour of grace will remain forever. This is the time to repent and bring forth fruits meet for repentance. May the register these in our to bear fruits in the name of Jesus!!! Amen.
