Theme: CONTEMPORARY SOCIAL VICES: THE CHRISTIAN VIEW

**Memory Verse:** Genesis 6:5 "And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually".

## Texts: Romans 1:18-27; Philippians 4:8-9, 1 Peter 1:6-11

Since the fall, Adam and all generations after him have become sensitive to evil imaginations and actions. Through the ages, mankind had draw out the evil traits in many different ways. Modern man lives in a world that "invent evil things" Man himself has a sin-generating mind. He has the capacity to generate or create sin, sinful pastimes or entertainment. Sin, in itself, is inexhaustible. It is brewed in the depth of human heart.

Man's craving for evil and vices are rampant. He ever craves for novelty in sin. Today, traditional sins are either weak in attraction or predictable in their nature.
