

**Theme: PROVISION FOR THE PEOPLE AMIDST GREAT FAMINE**

**Memory Verse:** *Philip. 4:19* “But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”

**Texts:** Genesis 41:55-57; Proverbs 6:6-8

The Egyptians cried unto Pharaoh, and Pharaoh directed them to Joseph. “And when all the land of Egypt was famished, the people cried to Pharaoh for bread: and Pharaoh said unto all the Egyptians, Go unto Joseph; what he saith to you, do” (Genesis 41:55). Joseph opened all the storehouses for abundant provision for the people. Their cry was assuaged. How similar is the New Testament account of the “finished wine” at the marriage at Cana!

Just as Pharaoh directed the people to Joseph; Mary, the mother of Jesus directed needy servants to Jesus, saying: “whatsoever he saith unto you, do it” “Jesus saith unto her, Woman, what have I to do with thee? Mine hour is not yet come. His mother saith unto the servants, whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.” (John 2:4-5) And Jesus turned their sorrow to joy, and their lack to abundance. For the New Testament believer, his abundant provision is in Jesus. He has in store all that you need. If you come to Him, believing, He will supply all your needs and lift you up.

Our sufficiency is in Him: “Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think anything as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God;” (2 Corinthians 3:5). Joseph through divine wisdom was able to provide for the land of Egypt and nations around them. So also Jesus by divine power saves the marriage feast in Cana by providing wine for them. The Bible says: “But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.” (Philip. 4:19). Trust in the Lord and He will fulfill the desire of your heart.
