Theme: PEOPLE'S LAMENTATION IN TIMES OF FAMINE

Memory Verse: Proverbs 24:10 "If thou faint in the day of adversity, thy strength is small."

Texts: Genesis 41:53-55; Proverbs 10:5

To the sceptics, the seven years of plenty in Egypt would appear unending, in defiance to Joseph's prediction. But the time of dearth came. "And the seven years of dearth began to come, according as Joseph had said: and the dearth was in all lands, but in all the land of Egypt there was bread" (Genesis 41:54). Though previously predicted, it would have met some people unprepared!

What a challenge to us waiting for Christ's Second Coming to take care of what we have, preserve the truth, so that we can survive this terrible world while awaiting the Rapture. For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation." (2 Peter 3:3-4).
