

**Theme:** GOD EXALTS JOSEPH

**Memory Verse:** *Galatians 6:9* “And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.”

**Texts:** Genesis 41:37-57

The dramatic turn of event in the life of Joseph, as we shall see in this lesson, encapsulates the intricate but rewarding dealing of God with His faithful children. A glimpse into Genesis chapter 37-40 reveals that there were ups and downs in the life of Joseph. From the hatred of his brothers that led to the plot to kill him, throwing into the pit, selling to the merchants, selling to Potiphar and suffering in the hand of Potiphar’s wife etc.

Our lesson today shows the happy ending to Joseph’s trials and throws great challenges to the New Testament believers assuring that God can lift His child from prison to the palace. It should be known that between your Vision and your victory are very rough roads, undulating terrains and diverse snares of the enemy of our souls. However, those who remain steadfast in faith will surely rejoice someday.
